Public stakeholder consultation event forms an important part of the implementation and certification processes in a carbon project.

The purpose of this stakeholder consultation is to inform and make aware relevant stakeholders of the subject project's specific features and technology intervention.

Local people, communities and or representatives who are directly or indirectly affected by the project.

Stakeholders with land-tenure rights for any area directly affected by the implementation of the project (i.e., within the project boundary).

Local policy makers and representatives of local authorities.

National government officials or National Focal bodies responsible for the project in the host country, for example, Designated National Authority (DNA) or equivalent body.

Local non-governmental organizations (NGOs), Women Groups working on topics relevant to the project or working with communities who are likely to be affected by the project.
